DOG LICENSING INFORMATION

Apply for Dog License at:

Village Hall, 80 Wheeler Avenue,
Pleasantville, NY 10570, 3rd floor, Room 303 or 306;
Monday-Friday, between 8:30-4:00p.m.;
914-769-1895 or 914-769-1975

OR go to www.pleasantville-ny.gov; choose DEPT.,
then OFFICE OF THE VILLAGE CLERK, then go to
FORMS AND APPLICATIONS for dog application.
Mail completed documents to the above address.

***License your dog at 4 months or older; after
the dog has received its rabies shot.**

Documentation required:

***A copy of your rabies certificate and
a completed application.**

***If your rabies certificate does not indicate
that your dog has been neutered/spayed; send
in a copy of the neutered/spayed certificate
from your veterinarian, OR your signed
affidavit confirming the dog was
neutered/spayed.**

Once we receive your application,
certificate(s), as well as the license fee, a dog
tag will be issued. Your license will be valid for
a one-year period, renewable in the month
that you originally licensed your dog. For your
convenience, renewal notices will be sent to
you on a yearly-basis.

Disposing Pet Waste

Please dispose pet waste in waste receptacle, which is
regularly emptied by the municipality, or another refuse
collector, or flush the waste down the toilet.

Rules & Regulations Pursuant to Village Code

****For Violations of Village Code, fines can be up to a
maximum of \$500.00. ****

**Dogs off the premises of the owner are to be
controlled as follows:**

- A. No dog shall be on private property without the
consent of the owner or person in control of such
property.
- B. No dog shall be off the premises of its owner or person
harboring such dog unless it is on a leash of no more than
eight feet in length.
- C. No dog shall be in any park or playground (unless
designated as a dog park).

Conduct of dogs

(1) It shall be unlawful for a dog to:

- (a) Engage in loud howling or barking or to conduct itself in
such a manner so as to unreasonably annoy any person
other than the owner or person harboring such dog.
- (b) Dump garbage and other receptacles.
- (c) Deposit fecal matter or urinate upon the property of
any person, firm or corporation except on roadways
adjacent to a curbside.
- (d) Fight with other dogs or injure another animal.
- (e) Tear, dig or otherwise destroy or damage the property of
any person, firm or corporation.
- (f) Chase or otherwise harass any person in such a manner as
reasonably to cause intimidation or to put such person in
reasonable apprehension of bodily harm or injury.
- (g) Chase or bark at motor vehicles, bicycles or moving
vehicles.
- (h) Attack, bite, molest, maul or harass without provocation
any person who is in any place where they may lawfully be.

**(2) A violation of any of the provisions of this subsection
shall constitute a separate offense.**

- (b) No owner shall permit the premises, structures or
enclosures in which a dog is kept to be so unclean or
unsanitary as to create a public nuisance.
- (c) No owner shall treat its dogs cruelly or inhumanely.
