

After School Activities Lottery System

Due to the huge popularity of the Pleasantville Recreation Departments After School Program, the Recreation Department has a lottery system for registration. We feel that this gives all our residents a fair opportunity. This lottery **does not** ensure that the classes will run or that you will be guaranteed a spot.

How to Register:

Registration forms will be distributed in the Bedford Road School, Recreation Department and online for you to print. Please visit www.pleasantville-ny.gov to print a copy of the registration form and medical release form. These forms need to be filled out completely. **No mail in registration will be accepted.**

Registration forms must be dropped off on or before **4:00 p.m., Wednesday, January 6th**. **Forms must be dropped off at the Recreation Department.** We will not accept any forms after 4:00 p.m. on Wednesday, January 6th.

How many choices do I get for classes?

Your child has a choice of two classes for the After School Program. On the registration form you may list a first choice and a second choice. We will try our best to ensure that your child will get their first choice, however we cannot guarantee this.

When will I know that my child has been placed into a class?

The lottery will be drawn on Thursday, January 7th. On Friday, January 8th the lottery results will be posted at the Bedford Road School, the Recreation Department and online at www.pleasantville-ny.gov.

How to pay for the class:

You have until **4:00 p.m. on Tuesday, January 19th** to **pay and register** for that class. **Checks or exact cash only, no credit cards accepted. You must register and pay in person by January 19th at the Recreation Department, 80 Wheeler Avenue, Room 304.** If any one fails to register by the January 19th deadline we will assume you are no longer interested in the class and will notify the next person on the lottery waiting list.



After School Activities at the Bedford Road School

The Pleasantville Recreation Department offers an after school program at the Bedford Road School from 3:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m. on Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday & Thursday. Due to the popularity of this program registration is done by a lottery system. The lottery and medical release forms for the After School Activities will be available at the Recreation Department, or you may also download these forms from the Recreation Department website www.pleasantville-ny.gov.

You will be able to list two choices on the lottery form. The registration deadline to enter this lottery is **4:00 p.m., Wednesday, January 6th**. The lottery will be drawn on Thursday, January 7th. On Friday, January 8th the lottery results will be posted at the school, the Recreation Department and on line, and you have until **Tuesday, January 19th** to pay and register for that class. After January 19th we will assume you are no longer interested in the class and we will notify the next person on the waiting list. The Recreation Department will also be open for you to register on Saturday, January 9th from 9:00 a.m. – 12:00 noon. Beginning Wednesday, January 20th you will be able to register for other After School Activities that still remain open.
