

Guidelines for Locating Your Tree

1. All trees are to be located on the applicant's property.
2. All trees are to be located in the applicant's front yard and set back approximately 15' from the street's curb.
3. The location should be accessible to light duty equipment to dig the hole for planting the tree.
4. The size of the hole that will be dug is approximately 4' wide by 2' deep.
5. Avoid locating your tree under or over any utilities, such as electric, gas, water or sewer lines.
6. Avoid planting the tree near any existing structures, such as retaining walls, walks or driveways.
7. No tree may be planted closer than 25' to an existing tree.
8. The number of new trees are limited to one per applicant.
9. Hammer the wooden stake in the desired location.
10. In some instances, it may not be practical to plant the tree at the resident's chosen location. In such cases, every effort will be made to plant the tree as close to the resident's chosen location as possible.

Planting the Tree

The tree will be furnished and planted by a contractor selected by the Village. The contractor will dig the hole, set the tree, wrap the trunk and anchor it to the ground with stakes.

Areas disturbed by the planting operation will be restored to an orderly condition. After one year, any dead trees will be replaced by the contractor. At the end of the year, the contractor will remove all stakes, guy wires and tree wrappings. After one year, you will become responsible for the care of your tree.
