

Pleasantville Pool Frequently Asked Questions

Who can use the Pleasantville Pool?

Use of the Pleasantville Pool is limited to residents of the Village of Pleasantville, the Pleasantville School District and the 10570 Zip Code area. You must hold one of the following passes to enter the Pleasantville Pool. These passes are a Family Plan, Individual Pass, Pay Tag*, and Senior Citizen.

Family Plan- Includes mother, father, or guardians and unmarried children under 21 living at home (children under 2 years of age are free).

Individual Pass- Season permit for an individual. Note: Live-in children Nannies/Housekeepers may purchase Resident Individual permits with proper ID.

Senior Citizen Pass- Anyone who is 62 years of age. Proof of age is required.

Pay Tag Pass- Pay a daily admission fee after purchasing permit. Note: Pay Tag holders may not bring guests.

Members of the Family Plan, Individual Pass, and Senior Citizen Pass are allowed two guests per pass, per day, at a cost of \$5.00 per guest.

What if I lost my Pool Pass?

There is a \$10.00 charge if you lose your ID card and need another photo taken.

What if I forget my Pool Pass?

If you do not have your photo ID when entering the pool, you will be charged a \$5.00 guest fee.

Can I pay a fee to enter the pool?

There is no daily pay fee to enter the pool.
