

Registration

Spring/Summer Program Registration will begin on Saturday, March 29 from 9:00 a.m. – 12:00 noon at the Recreation Department – 48 Marble Avenue. Registration will continue Monday thru Friday 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. Mail in registration is accepted, please see page 3. Registration is on a first-come, first-served basis. **Due to the popularity of our programs you will be permitted to register for your family only.** You must be 18 years old or older to register for a program. **Senior Citizen registration is on going at the Clinton Street Center.**

Refunds

Refunds will be made only when a class is cancelled due to insufficient enrollment. The participant assumes the risk of all changes in personal and business affairs. **Any refund request will be reviewed individually and will, if granted, be prorated and subject to a \$20.00 administrative processing fee.**

Programs

Are open to the Village of Pleasantville and School District residents first. Only those registered in the class will be permitted to attend. Residents residing outside the district may register, space permitting, for most programs one week after registration begins and pay an additional \$10.00 fee per program.

Program Cancellations

Inclement weather cancellations will be announced on WFAS, WHUD and on the Recreation answering machine, 769-7950. School District cancellations or early dismissal due to weather will automatically cancel all Recreation Programs.

The Village of Pleasantville does not carry insurance to cover hospitalization or medical costs of persons injured during participation or spectating at any Parks and Recreation programs. All participants enter programs at their own risk.

The Pleasantville Recreation Department offers an After School program at the Bedford Road School from 3:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m. on Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday & Thursday. We have found the lottery system to be very successful as it has given all our residents a fair opportunity. The lottery form is available at the Recreation Department and on line at www.pleasantville-ny.gov. You will be able to list one choice on the lottery form. Please bring or mail the lottery form to the Recreation Department by **Wednesday, March 26**. The lottery will be drawn on Thursday, March 27 and the results will be posted on-line and at the Recreation Center on Friday, March 28. You may pay and register for the class you have been chosen for beginning **Saturday, March 29 from 9:00 a.m. – 12:00 noon or Monday thru Friday, March 31 – April 4 from 8:00 a.m. – 4:00 p.m.** If you do not pay for the class by April 4 we will assume you are no longer interested in the class. Beginning **Monday, April 7** you will be able to register for any classes that still remain open.

How to Register:

Registration forms are available at the Recreation Department and online for you to print. Please visit www.pleasantville-ny.gov to print a copy of the registration form. These forms need to be filled out completely. **Lottery forms may be mailed in, but must be received in our mail by Wednesday, March 26. You will not be included in the lottery if the form does not arrive by mail by Wednesday, March 26.**

Registration forms must be dropped off, or received in our mail by 4:00 p.m., Wednesday March 26th. **No lottery forms will be accepted after 4:00 p.m. on March 26.**

How many choices do I get for classes?

Your child can choose one class for the lottery. Open registration begins on Monday, April 7 and you may sign up for additional classes at that time.

When will I know that my child has been placed into a class?

The lottery will be drawn on Thursday, March 27. On Friday, March 28 the lottery results will be posted at the Recreation Center and online at www.pleasantville-ny.gov.

How to pay for the class:

You have until **4:00 p.m. on Friday, April 4** to **pay and register** for that class. **Checks only, no cash or credit cards accepted. You must register by April 4.** If anyone fails to register by the deadline we will assume you are no longer interested in the class and open the class to others on April 7th. **YOU MAY REGISTER FOR YOUR CHILD ONLY.**




