GENERAL INFORMATION

Day Camp Mission Statement:

To provide a well planned wholesome, safe and fun recreation experience for your child.

The first grade will have the option of attending the 9:00 a.m - 12:00 p.m. Junior Camp or the full Day Senior Camp from 9:00 a.m. - 3:00 p.m. The Pleasantville Recreation and Parks Department will be offering a wide variety of programs to meet the needs of various age groups. Participants have the option of registering for a three week session or for six weeks. All camps are licensed by the Westchester County Department of Health and adhere to the regulations set by this agency. Campers to staff ratios are done in accordance to State guidelines. The Pleasantville Recreation and Parks Department will hire and train the best staff possible to care for your children. Camp will begin promptly at 9:00 a.m. Campers will meet at the Lake Street Pool or Bedford Road School according to the following schedule:

***Please do not drop your child off before 9:00 a.m. because there will be no supervision.**

Thursday - Specialists will be working with the program in addition to the regular camp staff. Activities may include sports, games, arts & crafts and special events at Bedford Road School.

** Each resident may register for one family other than their own & sign up with friends. Camp groups will be formed on a first come, first served basis as registrations are received.

The 2015 Pleasantville Day Camp registration form is available at the Recreation Office. This form can be filled out prior to registration day, which is **Saturday, March 14 from 9:00 a.m. - 12:00 p.m.** at the Recreation Center - 48 Marble Avenue. There will be a \$75.00 late fee after May 16 if space is still available. **THERE ARE NO REFUNDS.**

SENIOR CAMP - 1st - 6th Grades

Day Camp begins on Monday, June 29 and ends on Friday, August 7. Camp hours will be from 9:00 a.m. - 3:00 p.m. Campers must be dropped off and picked up on pool days (Monday & Tuesday) at the **Lake Street Pool**. On Monday afternoon we will be going on local trips and on Tuesday afternoon we will be utilizing **Nannahagan Park** and will have a variety of special events for campers, after their pool time. Call 769-7950 after 8:15 a.m. if weather is inclement. On (Wednesday, Thursday & Friday) drop off and pick up will be at **Bedford Road School**. **First graders have the option to attend the full or half day camp.**

Activities: Will be varied and campers will be on trips three times per week and participate in special events at Nannahagan Park and activities at the school.

Lunch: Parent's must provide their child's **non-perishable** lunch and a drink. Lunch can be purchased on pool days. Please have exact change.

Swimming: There will be free swim on pool days.

Trips: All fees for trips have been included in the registration fee. All trips require a permission slip, which must be filled out when you register your child. Some trips that may be included are Splashdown, Multiplex Movie Theater, Homefield Bowl, Quassy Amusement Park & My Three Sons.

It is at the parent's discretion to send money for treats or souvenirs.

Note: If your child is not feeling well please do not send him or her to camp. We want other campers to stay well. If your child has any special needs on a given day please notify us in writing. In the event that your child must leave camp early, or will be picked up by another parent or neighbor a written note giving permission to leave, time to be picked up and by whom, must be submitted to the camp director. In addition, you must inform your child's head counselor as well. **If weather is questionable on pool days and trips that are outside please call the Recreation Department at 769-7950 after 8:15 a.m. for information.**

Snack: Parents must provide their child's non-perishable snack and drink in a brown paper bag. If you choose to provide a snack for your child, please label it.

Swimming: There will be free swim on pool days. Children will be involved in water safety, water sports and games.

Trips: All fees for trips have been included in the registration fee. All trips require a permission slip, which must be filled out when you register your child. A trip will be provided on some Friday's for **Kindergarten & 1st grade only**.
Trips will not be provided for Tiny Tots.
