Online and walk-in registration will begin on Saturday, September 10 at 9am at the Recreation Center at 48 Marble Avenue and will be ongoing as program space allows. *Checks should be made payable to "Village of Pleasantville."* Payment can also be made via Visa and Mastercard.

## REGISTER FOR PROGRAMS EARLY!

Registration is on a first-come, first-served basis. Due to the popularity of our programs you will be permitted to register for your family only. You must be 18 years old or older to register for a program. Please be advised that due to the access to registration that our online system provides, it is possible for certain programs to fill up in a very short period of time and a waitlist to be started.

*Nothing eliminates a recreation program faster than participants who wait until the last minute to register.* There is a point when a program must be cancelled or modified if there is insufficient registration. All programs require a high level of coordination, often including facility scheduling, staffing, and volunteer recruitment and purchasing of supplies. **PLEASE DO NOT WAIT TO REGISTER!**

# POLICIES AND DISCLAIMERS

## NON-DISCRIMINATION STATEMENT ON THE BASIS OF DISABILITY

The Village of Pleasantville will not discriminate against any individual on the basis of disability with regard to the full and equal enjoyment of the goods and services of all programs. The Village of Pleasantville will make reasonable modifications to its policies, practices, or procedures when necessary to afford its goods and services to individuals with disabilities, including children with allergies and who may require the administration of medications, unless the Village of Pleasantville can demonstrate that making the modifications would fundamentally alter the nature of its services or not otherwise be feasible.

## MEDICAL INSURANCE POLICY

As an applicant for participation in recreation programs sponsored by the Village of Pleasantville, it is extremely important that you are aware that the Village does not provide medical insurance in such programs. If you do not have a personal medical insurance policy, we urge that you secure one prior to enrolling in any programs. Persons participate at their own risk and should make certain they have their own insurance.

## WEATHER CANCELLATIONS

In the case of closure or early dismissal of the Pleasantville Union Free School District, all after-school and evening programs are automatically CANCELLED. In the event of a delayed start, all programs starting prior to 12:00 noon will be cancelled. Participants will be notified of the status of their classes via email through our Community Pass Registration system. They may also call our office at 914-769-7950 for further information.

## REFUND POLICY

Refunds will be made only when a class is cancelled due to insufficient enrollment or any other departmental cancellation reason. The participant assumes the risk of all changes in personal and business affairs. All refunds will be Village Board approved. Once approved a refund check will be sent to the primary account holder. Any refund request will be reviewed individually and will, if granted, be prorated and subject to a \$20.00 administrative processing fee.
