The Recreation Department has an on line registration process for all Recreation programs. Capturepoint's "Community Pass" program is designed to expedite and streamline the registration for our users. Below are brief instructions on how to access the online system:

- 1. Log on to <https://register.communitypass.net/VillageofPleasantville> and create your profile now.**
- 2. Click on "Create an account for your family now"**
- 3. Complete the account information and click submit**
- 4. Click on "Register Now" to begin registering for programs**

Follow the instructions on the resulting pages to add individuals to your family account and register for all programs available from Pleasantville Recreation Department. Depending on the age, grade or gender of the members of your family account, the system will display the programs that each family member is eligible for (i.e., an 8 year old will be eligible for Summer Camp, but not Adult Open Gym.)

Please note:

If you are waitlisted for a class and space becomes available we will notify you by e-mail. Follow the link in the e-mail to register. You will have three days to register for the class after you receive the e-mail notification.

If you fail to register for the class within the three day period we will assume you are no longer interested in the class. You will then be removed from the waiting list so we can offer this class to the next person on the list.

Winter walk-in registration will begin on Saturday, January 7 from 9:00 a.m. – 12:00 noon at the Recreation Center 48 Marble Avenue and will continue Monday thru Friday 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. **On-line registration begins at 9:00 a.m. on January 7 and is on-going.** Registration is on a first-come, first-served basis. **Due to the popularity of our programs you will be permitted to register for your family only.** You must be 18 years old or older to register for a program. **Senior Citizen registration is on going at the Clinton Street Center.**

Refunds

Refunds will be made only when a class is cancelled due to insufficient enrollment. The participant assumes the risk of all changes in personal and business affairs. Credit card refunds will be refunded back to your credit card. **Any refund request will be reviewed individually and will, if granted, be prorated and subject to a \$20.00 administrative processing fee.**

Programs

Programs are open to the Village of Pleasantville and School District residents first. Only those registered in the class will be permitted to attend. Residents residing outside the district may register, space permitting, for most programs one week after registration begins and pay an additional \$10.00 fee per program.

Program Cancellations

Inclement weather cancellations will be announced on WHUD and on the Recreation answering machine, 769-7950. School District cancellations or early dismissal due to weather will automatically cancel all Recreation Programs.

Insurance

The Village of Pleasantville does not carry insurance to cover hospitalization or medical costs of persons injured during participation or spectating at any Parks and Recreation programs. All participants enter programs at their own risk.
