

General Registration Information

Online and Walk-In registration will begin on Thursday, September 9 at 9am at the Recreation Center at 48 Marble Avenue and will be ongoing as program space allows. <u>Checks should be made payable to "Village of</u> <u>Pleasantville."</u> Payment can also be made via Visa and Mastercard.

Senior Citizen registration is on-going at the Clinton Street Center.

Registration is on a first-come, first-served basis. Due to the popularity of our programs you will be permitted to register for your family only. You must be 18 years old or older to register for a program. Please be advised that due to the access to registration that our online system provides, it is possible for certain programs to fill up in a very short period of time and a waitlist to be started.

Register for Programs Early!

Nothing eliminates a recreation program faster than participants who wait until the last minute to register. There is a point when a program must be cancelled or modified if there is insufficient registration. All programs require a high level of coordination, often including facility scheduling, staffing, volunteer recruitment and purchasing of supplies. PLEASE DO NOT WAIT TO REGISTER!

- Make sure you have an established account. Do NOT create a "New" account if you have registered with us before.

Non-Discrimination Statement on the Basis of Disability

Medical Insurance Policy

As an applicant for participation in recreation programs sponsored by the Village of Pleasantville, it is extremely important that you are aware that the Village does not provide medical insurance in such programs. If you do not have a personal medical insurance policy, we urge that you secure one prior to enrolling in any programs. Persons participate at their own risk and should make certain they have their own insurance.

Weather Cancellations

In the case of closure or early dismissal of the Pleasantville Union Free School District, all after-school and evening programs are automatically CANCELLED. In the event of a delayed start, all programs starting prior to 12 Noon will be cancelled.


