JUNIOR CAMP – 3-4-year old & Entering Kindergarten Parents May Not Remain at Camp

Day Camp begins on Monday, July 1 and will end on Friday, August 9. Camp hours are 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. Camp will begin promptly at 9:00 a.m. Campers will meet at the **Lake Street Pool** or at **Bedford Road School**.

Activities: Children will participate in activities that develop their creativity, motor skills and

self-esteem in a non-threatening environment. Some activities will include

games, arts and crafts, trips, special events and free time.

<u>Snack:</u> Parents must provide their camper with a non-perishable snack and drink. Please

label it with your child's name.

<u>Swimming:</u> There will be free swim on pool days. Children will be involved in

water safety, water sports and games. Swim Test is required for all campers that

will use the big pool.

Note: If your child is not feeling well please do not send him or her to

camp. We want other campers to stay well. If your child has any special needs on a given day please notify us in writing. In the event

that your child must leave camp early, or will be picked up by another parent or neighbor a <u>written note</u> giving permission to leave, time to be picked up and by whom, must be submitted to the

camp director. In addition, you must inform your child's head

counselor as well. If weather is questionable on pool days you will receive a text message and email or call the Recreation Department at

769-7950 after 8:15 a.m. for information.

PARENT ORIENTATION – Wednesday, June 12, at 6:30 p.m. at the Recreation Center-48 Marble Avenue.

The camper's dates of immunization are required. Please upload to Community Pass the immunization record and Covid Vaccination record (required if vaccinated). All Junior Campers must be 3 years old by 12/1/23 and be eligible for Kindergarten by 2024. MUST PROVIDE US WITH A COPY OF THEIR BIRTH CERTIFICATE. THEY MUST BE POTTY TRAINED. Registration will not be complete until all records are on file.

<u>SENIOR CAMP – Entering 1st - 5th Grades</u> Parents May Not Remain at Camp

On Tuesday and Thursday afternoons we will be utilizing Nannahagan Park and will have a variety of special events for campers, after their pool time.
