

BLOTTER SUMMARY

12/20/2021 through 12/26/2021

The blotter reports listed below represent a selection of reports made between the dates listed above.

12/20/2021 10:16am A home health worker employed by a family in the Pleasantville Country Club reports the woman she cares for has fallen and needs assistance. Responding officers were able to help the woman, who did not sustain any injuries.

12/20/2021 3:07pm A resident of Manville Road reports she has been the victim of a scam. The woman was contacted by an unknown party who claimed to be an employee of the federal government. After a number of telephone transfers, the woman was convinced there were arrest warrants pending for her. In order to prevent her "arrest", the victim set up an account and wired a large amount of money to the perpetrators. The investigation is continuing.

12/20/2021 4:48pm A mother of a young man with special needs called to report her son was being disruptive. After spending some time with the young man, the officers were able to calm him down.

12/20/2021 7:33pm A resident of Saratoga Avenue called to report a loud disturbance at his neighbor's house. Responding officers discovered two tenants in the midst of a loud argument. After interviewing both parties, responding officers were able to restore calm to the situation.

12/21/2021 3:15pm Officers responded to a call of a two-car motor vehicle accident near the intersection of Bedford Road and Pierce Drive. No injuries were reported. A New York State accident report was filed.
