Garbage/Recycling Pickup Reminder

Reminder to residents that the Village offers non-curbside pickup of garbage and recycling for plastics, cans & bottles. Bulk pickup and Thursday recycling (cardboard and paper) MUST be curbside. Please note the non-curbside recycling pickup is for Friday schedule only (please see **Sanitation Schedule** on website). Homeowners need to ensure there is a clear hardened path (of at least 3 ft. in width for cart/can) from roadside to the garbage/recycling location for access. **Multifamily dwellings are entitled to one (1) pickup location.** For those interested in non-curbside pickup, please call the Department of Public Works at 914-769-3883 to confirm location of pickup.

RECYCLING CENTER: Is open on Saturdays from 9AM-3PM for Village Residents <u>ONLY</u> to drop off metal and electronics only. NO air conditioners or appliances with Freon are allowed.

2020 YARD WASTE COLLECTION INFORMATION:

All yard waste will be collected on Thursdays. There is <u>one (1) exception</u> where yard waste is cancelled:

Thanksgiving Day (Thursday, November 26th)

** YARD WASTE WILL NOT BE PICKED UP IN PLASTIC BAGS **

MUST BE OUT TO CURB BY 7AM

Yard waste includes leaves, grass clippings, flowers, fruits, vegetables and plants.

All must be placed in PAPER BAGS or containers that weigh less than 50 pounds.

Leaf pick-up typically begins the 3rd week in October and will be done on a weekly basis. Leaves shall be put curbside.

After the first snow fall, ALL leaves MUST BE BAGGED.

Branches, tied or placed in containers, must be less than 4 feet in length and under 6 inches in diameter and placed curbside.

The Village does not pick up dirt, rocks, or logs.
