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## LOTTERY REGISTRATION GUIDELINES AND PROCEDURE

- Summer Camp Lottery Registration will begin Monday, 3/29 at 8am and run through 4pm on Friday, 4/9 at <https://register.communitypass.net/VillageofPleasantville>. No registrations will be taken outside of that timeframe; NO EXCEPTIONS. Please note that there is NO ADVANTAGE to registering sooner; anyone who registers within that timeframe has equal chance of getting a camp slot. At this time, no payment will be necessary. Register **EACH CHILD** that you are wishing to register for Camp.
- During the Camp Lottery Registration process, you will be asked whether you want to register your child for Session 1, Session 2, or the Full Summer. Please indicate your choice.
- The Lottery Drawing process will begin on Monday, April 12. Camp slots will be filled accordingly based on open groups and pod compatibility. Due to COVID restrictions, friend or other placement requests cannot be considered. Please note that to maximize slot use, some campers may be placed in groups outside their immediate age group.
- Those whose numbers are picked will be notified by the Recreation Department that they may proceed to the next step in the registration process. This will involve payment, as well as instructions on how to provide additional information—such as medical and immunization information. Please note that to attend camp, this piece is required; if not provided, your child will not be able to participate. Please allow until Friday, April 16 to carry out the process before calling our office for updates.

## ITEMS TO NOTE REGARDING THE CAMP LOTTERY

- NO logistical advantage will be given to Village Residents over School District Residents. The only difference is the rate charged to go to camp.
- NO preference will be given to those who desire 6 weeks of camp versus 3. Slots will be filled as they are drawn.
- The siblings of campers drawn from the lottery will also be given slots automatically. However, ALL siblings MUST be registered in the lottery draw to qualify.

## CAMP SCHOLARSHIPS / FINANCIAL AID

- If your child is currently receiving free lunch through the Pleasantville School District due to financial hardship, you are likely eligible for financial aid for Camp! If you would be interested in this option, please indicate as such during registration for the lottery. It is one of the prompts you will be given during the process! All information is confidential.



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## IMPORTANT THINGS TO KNOW!

- Due to COVID protocols set forth by the Department of Health, masks will be required for all campers and staff at all times, aside from designated “mask breaks.”
- Campers will be assigned to pods of no more than 15 children; those groups will not be able to intermingle during the day, and their activities will be separated by distances of at least 12 feet.
- Because we are unable to hold programs indoors, camp will be canceled in the event of inclement weather. We will notify participants as soon as it is reasonably viable to do so, so alternate childcare may be made in advance.
- Trips will not be offered due to capacity and travel restrictions from COVID.
- Please do NOT send your child to camp if they are not feeling well; this could potentially result in entire groups of campers needing to be sent home!
- There will be NO REFUNDS; please consider this prior to submitting your registration!
