



Westchester saw the 7th highest growth in the NYC Metro Area and grew more than the NYS population as a whole.

Regional Population Changes

- The County's under 18 population decreased by 2.6%, where NYS lost 4.9%
 - Putnam lost 18%
 - Rockland grew 12.8%
- County's Hispanic population grew 30.1% where NYS saw a 15.5% increase
 - Putnam grew 52.3%
 - Manhattan lost .2%
- County's Black population grew 3.5% where NYS lost .9%
 - Orange grew 22%
 - Brooklyn lost 8.7%
- County's housing units increased 4.9% on par with NYS' 4.7%
 - Manhattan had greatest increase at 7.9%
 - Putnam had smallest increase at .2%

County Population

- Population grew to 1,004,457 (+55,344/+5.8%)
- 18+ grew to 77.8% of population (+1.9% from 2010)
 - Under 18 decreased 5,085 (-2.5%: 228,000-222,015)
- No "Majority" population in Westchester
 - 3 municipalities are minority majority (PTC/SLH and MTV)
 - 49.5% of total population Non-Hispanic White
 - 41% of under 18
- More Housing Units and fewer are vacant
- Better self-response rates likely helped municipalities
 - County above 2010 & 2000 rates
 - 79% above 2010
 - 8 above 80% self-response
- Fewer Group Quarters residents



Population by Municipality

- Municipal populations changed between +14.1% to -3.8%
- Highest populations by numbers:

• #	t1 - Yonkers	211,569	(+15,594	+8%)
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- Mount Pleasant had the "Hardest to Count" Census Tract
- Ardsley and Buchanan are still #42 and #43 respectively
 - Ardsley greatest % increase 14.1% (627 people)
 - Pleasantville #31 +494 people since 2010

Greatest population changes by percentage:

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• #1 – Ardsley +14.1% (+627)

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• #10 - Yonkers +8% (+15,594)
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Hispanic Population by Municipality

- Total Hispanic population: 269,334; increased 62,302 (+30.1%)
- Municipal Hispanic populations ALL increased from a high of +88.8% to a low of +4.8% (only SLH below 15% increase)
- Greatest population by percentage of total municipality:

```
• #1 – Port Chester 65.3% (20,679; +3,486)
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• #2 – Sleepy Hollow 52.9% (5,280; +242)

• #3 – Ossining Village 47.4% (13,061; +2,686)

• #4 – Peekskill 43.9% (11,160; +2,447)

• #5 – Elmsford 43.7% (2,290; +520)

- 26.8% of County population is Hispanic
- 11 municipalities had growth greater than 50% (PLV +28.5%)
- 30 have a Hispanic population over 10%; 13 are over 20%

Black Population by Municipality

- County Black population: 131,010; + 4,425 (+3.5%)
 - Overall percentage of population dropped from 13.3% to 13%
- Municipal Black populations changed +366.7% to -58.5%
- Greatest population by percentage of total municipality:

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• #1 - Mount Vernon 60.4% (44,655; +3,429)
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• #2 - Peekskill 18.5% (4,693; -359)

• #3 - New Rochelle 18.0% (14,324; +368)

• #4 - Elmsford 17.8% (5,239; +12)

• #5 - Greenburgh 16.3% (7,509; +45)

- 15 municipalities had +10% growth; 13 had +10% decrease
- 24 saw Black percentage of total population drop
- 19 municipalities decreased in person counts (PLV -17.4%)

Asian Population by Municipality

- County Asian population: 64,907; +13,784 (+27%)
- Municipal Asian populations changed +93.9% to a loss of -6.5%
- Greatest population by percentage of total municipality:

```
• #1 – Scarsdale 20.9% (+1,596)
```

- #5 Harrison 11.5% (+1,169)
- County Asian population increased from 5.4% to 6.5%
- 7 municipalities above 10%; 5 below 3% (PLV 6.4%)
- Yonkers (most) at 12,915; Buchanan (least) at 64
- Pleasantville increased 53.5% (+168 people)

Greatest population changes by percentage:

• #1 – Buchanan +93.9% (+31)
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• #14 - Greenburgh +1,909 (+36.5%)
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• 3 municipalities lost Asian population: Mount Kisco -2 (-.4%); Sleepy Hollow -8 (-2.6%); and Tarrytown -58 (-6.5%)

Housing Units by Municipality

- County Housing Units 388,963 +18,142 (+4.9%)
- Municipality housing units changed +12.9% to a loss of -1.5%
- Greatest increases by percentage (and by numbers below):

• #1 – Ossining Village 12.9% (+1,142)

• #2 – Somers 12.9% (+1,028)

• #3 – Elmsford 12% (+209)

• #4 – Briarcliff Manor 11.3% (+312)

• #5 – Port Chester 10% (+1,008)

• #11 - Yonkers 5,139 (6.4%)

#17 - Mount Vernon 1,360 (4.7%)

3 municipalities lost units; Bedford -12 (.2%); Pelham Village -19 (-.7%); and Pound Ridge -32 (-1.5%) (PLV +8.9%/238 units – 6th!)

Occupancy of Units by Municipality

2015 ACS estimate showed decrease of about 500 units

• Occupied Housing units: 367,296 +20,064 (+5.8%)

• Vacant Housing units: 21,667 -1,922 (-8.1%)

18 municipalities saw increases in vacant units from 2 to 324

Highest vacant units:

Briarcliff Manor +324

New Rochelle +196

• Somers +194

Mount Pleasant +55

Only Cortlandt had exact number as 2010 at 774 units

Lowest changes in vacant units:

Peekskill -2; Sleepy Hollow -3; Irvington -6; Mount Kisco -7

Group Quarters by Municipality

- Group Quarters population decreased -4,276 (24,428 total)
- Group Quarters in EVERY municipality from 3,519 units to 14
- Municipalities with the greatest populations in Group Quarters:

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• #1 – New Rochelle 3,519 (+242)
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• #2 – Harrison 3,359 (-926* greatest loss!)

• #3 – Yonkers 2,934 (-352)

• #4 – Mount Pleasant 2,455 (-281)

#5 – Ossining Village 1,610 (-248)

- Other significant gains: Tuckahoe +135; North Castle +110;
 Cortlandt +104
- Other significant losses: Dobbs Ferry -550; Tarrytown -443;
 Briarcliff Manor -439 (PLV -153/-44.2%)


Density by Municipality

Few changes in density by municipality:

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- 1. Mount Vernon 4.39 miles 16,821/per square mile (psm)
- 2. Port Chester 2.33 miles 13,613 psm
- 3. Tuckahoe .60 miles 11,787 psm (2010 ranked 4th)
- 4. Yonkers 18.01 miles 11,750 psm (2010 ranked 3rd)
- Hastings, Elmsford, Pleasantville (19^{th vs} 20th) and Ardsley all moved up
- Least dense Pound Ridge at 228 p/psm (w/22.31 miles)
